Chapter 1606 and 1607 Students

The VA and DOD will now prohibit using Chapter 1606 or 1607 along with Federal Tuition Assistance. If you have requested 1606 or 1607 benefits and TA, you will have to choose which one you would like to use.

1606 and 1607 benefits are what you request through Veterans Support Services by completing our paper form each term.

TA is requested on online on a course-by-course ba-

sis through GoArmyEd or the AI portal.

If you used GoArmyEd for a degree plan and statement of understanding as part of your paper application for the National Guard Supplemental Grant through Ms. Madison. This is not considered TA and you and can use 1606/1607 with the NGSG.

If you already know that you have requested both TA and Chapter 1606 or 1607, please contact our

office saying which one you would like to use. We will be sending emails out asking which you would prefer to use.
