### Purpose of the Project

This booklet is a brief look at Ball State University and what it has to offer the student. It serves as an exploration of the many facets of the printing process. On the surface the booklet is a pictorial and written description of Ball State's colleges, campus and community. Below the surface it is a series of careful exercises in photography, design, computer image manipulation, planning, printing and finishing of a multi-color printed product.
