ALPHA	1920	(Affiliated Alpha Chi Omega nationally 1950)
GAMMA GAMMA	1920	(Affiliated Pi Beta Phi nationally 1952)
PI ZETA	October, 1920	(Affiliated Sigma Kappa nationally 1954)
LAMBDA DELTA PHI	1920	In 1920, ten women formed a club known as Lllamaradas and in 1923 formed the sorority. On November 1, 1938, this sorority dropped all affiliations with the Alpha Chapter and joined forces with two other Ball State sororities, namely the Epsilon Delta and the Phi Delta Xi to form the new sorority Phi Delta Lambda.
SIGMA ALPHA SIGMA	1920	(December 12, 1936 affiliated Alpha Sigma Alpha nationally)
MU ZETA	November 5, 1921	(Affiliated Sigma Sigma Sigma nationally on April 21, 1945)
KAPPA KAPPA	1922	(Affiliated Alpha Omicron Pi nationally 1952)
PHI DELTA XI	1922	(On November 1, 1938, this sorority joined forces with two other Ball State sororities, namely the Epsilon Delta and Lambda Delta Phi to form the new sorority Phi Delta Lambda)
EPSILON DELTA	January 20, 1923	(November 1, 1938, this sorority dropped all affiliations with the Alpha chapter and joined forces with two other Ball State sororities, the Lambda Delta Phi and the Phi Delta Xi to form the new sorority Phi Delta Lambda)
OMEGA SIGMA CHI	October 1923	(Affiliated Delta Zeta nationally 1953)
SIGMA BETA TAU	October 1924	(Affiliated Pi Kappa Sigma nationally on September 9, 1945)

PSI THETA	February 28, 1925 (Affiliated nationally with Chi Omega in 1952)
DELTA SIGMA ATHLETS	February 17, 1926 (Affiliated Alpha Sigma Tau nationally 1945)
ALPHA SIGMA ALPHA	December 12, 1936 Was formerly known as the Sigma Alpha Sigma (national)
PHI DELTA LAMBDA	November 1, 1938, three sororities: the Epsilon Delts, Lambda Delta Phi and the Phi Delta Xi joined forces to create Phi Delta Lambda. On September 23, 1944, this sorority affiliated with Delta Sigma Epsilon national.
DELTA SIGMA EPSILON	September 23, 1944 (formerly Phi Delta Lambda) merged at national level with Delta Zeta in 1956 and now known as Delta Zeta.
SIGMA SIGMA SIGMA	April 21, 1945 (formerly Mu Zeta)
PI KAPPA SIGMA	September 9, 1945 (formerly Sigma Beta Tau) Merged at national level with Sigma Kappa in 1959 and now known as Sigma Kappa.
DELTA SIGMA THETA	1953 This was the year the national was established on campus -- no previous local
KAPPA TAU SIGMA	1960 Founded at Ball State University
GAMMA THETA	May, 1961 Recognized as a local sorority on our campus. Affiliated nationally with Alpha Phi in June, 1961.
ALPHA PHI	November, 1964 At this time, Gamma Theta affiliated nationally with Alpha Phi
SIGMA BETA CHI	January 17, 1966. Approved by Panhellenic Council as a local sorority April 7, 1967. Formerly installed as a chapter of Delta Gamma national sorority on April 11, 1970.
KAPPA THETA RHO	Founded on October 30, 1967. Approved by Panhellenic Council as a local sorority May 8, 1968. Affiliated with Kappa Alpha Theta national sorority early in 1970.

ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA Kappa Tau Sigma was accepted in September, 1963 as a chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha national sorority.

SIGMA KAPPA ALPHA Founded on October 16, 1968. Approved by Panhellenic Council as a local sorority on October 30, 1969.

DELTA GAMMA Local sorority Sigma Beta Chi was accepted as a chapter of Delta Gamma national sorority in November, 1969. Formal installation was April 11, 1970.

KAPPA ALPHA THETA Local sorority Kappa Theta Rho accepted as a chapter of Delta Gamma national sorority in November, 1969. Formal installation was April 11, 1970.

BETA CHI Chapter was accepted in April 24, 1980 as a chapter of Delta Delta Delta national sorority.
